What is the biggest barrier to transplantation in your region?

- limited number of medical staff
- limited financial resources and inadequate costs of transplant
- lack of medication to treat VOD, resistant GVHD, viral infections (vistid)
- lack of molecular means to monitor of infections (PCR for EBV,CMV.)
- lack of informatic support of medical reports and data managers.
- language barrier (frensh)
- insensitivity of the gouvernement to the needs of the team

After allogeneic: TRM = 8/45 (17.7%) and relapse 4 pts
